What's the Future of Foreign Garbage Removal In the Port of Baltimore

Wheelabrator Technologies (BRESCO) in Baltimore is Davis Ship Service's designated incinerator for foreign garbage. With the threat of the facility shutting down, vessels calling the Port of Baltimore would no longer be able to discharge their garbage.

A decision by China to stop importing and processing America's recyclable materials limited the U.S.'s option for local disposal and recycling. In the midst of this waste crisis, the State of Maryland and city of Baltimore, have challenged themselves to

achieve a "zero waste" future which would require many changes in waste management and recycling. Possibly leaving Davis Ship Service with no choice but to dispose of the garbage in another state making the service very difficult to provide and high costs to the ship owner.

Wheelabrator had been negotiating a new contract with the city since its deal is set to expire at the end of 2021. On November 4, 2020 a panel of Baltimore's top officials voted and approved a 10-year contract extension with the operator of the BRESCO incinerator.

The agreement that was approved by the board grants Wheelabrator a \$106 million extension through 2031 to keep processing the city's waste. In exchange for another decade of the city's business, Wheelabrator has offered to invest nearly \$40 million into improvements to BRESCO to reduce nitrogen oxide and other toxic emissions.


